

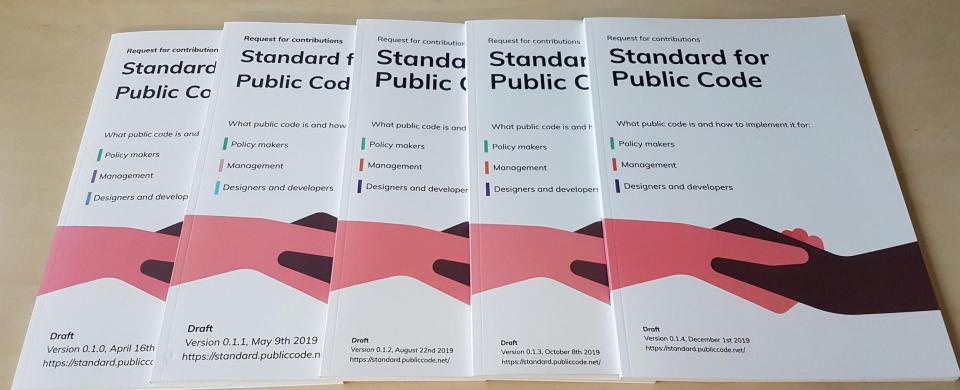



### Requirements

- Software source code MUST be licensed under an OSI-approved or FSF Free/Libre license.
- All source code files in the codebase SHOULD include a copyright notice and a license header that are machine-readable.
- Having multiple licenses for different types of code and documentation is **OPTIONAL**.
- Following nomenclature in <u>IETF RFC 2119</u>

### **Compliance and certification**

- Open standard anyone can start using it
- Review template and checklist are available
- <u>standard-compliant.publiccode.net</u> contains a list of all compliant codebases and which release was reviewed (also includes a list of all codebases with a public commitment to adhere to the standard)


